

# Lions fall, Mustangs get scare from Cougars

## Set to butt heads with Rhinos Saturday



The Bantam AAA North Shore Lions lost their first game since 2003 last weekend when they traveled to Ste. Thérèse and lost to the Laurentian Wildcats 20-15. Before last weekend, the Lions had won a remarkable 78 straight regular-season and playoff games since they last lost the provincial final in 2003.

Shawn Steen opened the scoring for the Lions with a 35-yard field goal, while the Wildcats countered with a 1-yard touchdown pass with under a minute remaining in the first quarter. The Wildcats missed the extra point.

Steen hit on two more field goals before the end of the first half, and the Lions led at halftime 9-6.

With no scoring in the third frame, Laurentian scored two touchdowns in the fourth – the second with just 3:44 to play in the game – and despite a last-gasp touchdown from the Lions' Iylan Grandison, the Lions fell 20-15.

Despite the loss, the Lions finished the season with a 9-1 record and had already clinched the Quebec Bantam Football League's Bill Allan division championship. They will take on the LaSalle warriors at home to open the playoffs.

### Mustangs still perfect

The midget AAA North Shore Mustangs moved their undefeated record to 9-0 with a tight 10-7 win over the St. Leonard Cougars Saturday night at Glenn McHugh Field in Dollard des Ormeaux. Mustang starting pivot Max St. James went down with an injury in the second quarter and the Mustangs had to hang on the backup at the helm.

The Mustangs look to complete their first undefeated regular season in years with

a home win over the expansion Lanaudière Rhinos, whom they hammered 69-7 in the season opener. Game time is Saturday at 7 p.m. at Glenn McHugh Field.
